III. Presentations and Reports

A. Budget Review and Project Update – Brad Mason

Mr. Mason updated the Committee on the status of obtaining new locking mechanisms and peepholes for doors in all classrooms. The District evaluated every door with Ingersoll-Rand and determined there are 19 different types of locks throughout the school sites. The district is currently putting together bid specs and hoping the door locks will be completed this school year.

Mr. Mason gave the Committee an informative update on the Redlands High School Fencing Project (part of Measure J) noting that at this time there won't be much movement with Measure R projects. Chairperson Rendler mentioned that some sites don't have parking lots by sports fields. Mr. Mason suggested parents and community members address site specific concerns with site administration and to also share their concerns with him, noting that he wants to make sure he represents the trust given to the District by the people.

IV. For the Good of the Order/Member Comments

Chairperson Rendler informed Mr. Mason that quite often, the gates at Smiley are unlocked. Mr. Mason informed the Committee that all sites need to have at least one gate unlocked so the public has access to the fields. He also noted that various groups are scheduled to use our fields after school hours.
